a) UNESCO Listed Towns in South Bohemia & Vienna (4 days/3 nights – full board)

Departure: 17:30 hrs. on Thursday 06th May - from Prague HILTON Atrium – bus parking place Return to Prague: 13:00 hrs. on Sunday 09th May 1– stop in city centre and Prague International Airport

The tour will take you to South Bohemian region so typical for its unique village folklore architecture and picturesque landscape. Many lakes and water reservoirs have been created in this area in the middle ages and fish-farming does have a long tradition. Accommodation will be arranged in a hotel situated on the main (and mostly the only) square in the small charming spa town Třeboň,

UNESCO Listed Town. The town is surrounded by meadows and forests and a large water reservoir is just 100 metres from the hotel. Are you fond of fishing and relax – just do not miss this tour!

During a full-day excursion to Austria you will visit Vienna (former capital of Austro-Hungarian Monarchy) and see most of Vienna landmarks - walk in the city centre (St. Stephen Cathedral, Graben, Opera House), have lunch in a typical restaurant, followed by sightseeing along the Ringstrasse passing landmarks of the city (Museum of Fine Arts, Museum of Natural History, Hofburg, Parliament, City Hall, Burgtheatre, University). Inspection of the most important imperial appartments in Schonbrunn Palace. Another full-day trip will take you to another UNESCO Listed Town – Český Krumlov, especially known for the well preserved ancient city centre, a large medieval castle complex and open-air theatre. You will have the opportunity to sample Czech Budvar beer right at the place of its origin - in České Budějovice, South Bohemian metropolis.

Included: three nights' accommodation including breakfast, full board starting with dinner on first day and breakfast on the last day,

English speaking guide, transportation in air-conditioned bus, entrance fees as per programme.

b) Moravian Wine (3 days/2 nights – full board)

Departure: 17:30 hrs. on Thursday 06th May – from Prague HILTON Atrium – bus parking place Return to Prague: 14:00 hrs. on Saturday 08th May – stop in city centre and Prague International Airport

The tour will take you to South Moravia, mostly agricultural region with a rich viniculture tradition, historic heritage and natural reserves.

Accommodation will be provided in a chateau, formerly a fort which around the 13th century belonged to the order of Templar Knights. The history of the chateau is linked with the history of wine production in the region. In 1624 the chateau was rebuilt by the new owners – the order of Jesuits. May you wish to see (and taste) more of the history of the chateau and underground wine cellars – just come and see for yourselves!

The tour will also take you to Slavkov/Austerlitz – one of the Napoleon battlefields. You will visit the museum and the battlefield memorial

Have you never sailed an underground river before? This is just the opportunity as Macocha underground river is running just through the Moravian Karst Region which will be inspected.

The trip to South Moravia would not be complete without a wine tasting in a typical wine cellar. Just come to give it a try! On the return trip to Prague a short stop over in Brno, "the capital of Moravia" will be included.

English speaking guide, transportation in air-conditioned bus, entrance fees as per programme.

USEFUL INFORMATION

(up-to-date on launch of the Registration Form)

Currency:

1 CZK – Czech Crown (Kč – koruna česká) = 100 hellers (hal. – haléř)

1 USD = approx. 29 - 31 CZK, 1 DEM = 16.70 - 17.50 CZK (August 1998)

Use banks or hotel exchange-offices for money exchange. Never change money in the street.

Keep your bank/exchange receipts for eventual re-exchange on your return journey.

Major credit cards accepted in hotels and most downtown shops.

Voltage, sockets, plugs:

220 V, European norm, three-pole earthed plugs have two pins and a hole in the plug and one pin with two holes in the sockets. Adaptors only available in higher cathegory hotels and specialized shops.

Insurance

Visitors from abroad are recommended to take out insurance in the country of origin or permanent residence before travelling to the Czech Republic as the Czech insurance companies do not insure foreigners.

Transportation:

- Metro = underground/subway very fast and efficient, three lines - each marked with a different colour
- Tickets same tickets are valid on metro, trams and city busses. Can be purchased in hotel reception, tobacconists' and from slot machines at the entrance to metro stations. Price of a single journey ticket is CZK 12 (approx. 40 ¢) must be validated at the entrance to metro or on the tram/bus and is valid max. 45 min. A variety of passes also available.
- It is recommended to take same precautions against pick pocketers as elsewhere in the world.
- Taxis a permanent service available from the airport to hotels (approx. CZK 600-900) and railway stations. Fares shall be visibly posted on the cars. May you have doubts, check the price before the journey this may help to avoid misunderstanding. In case of any dispute ask the receptionist to assist you.
- Shuttle service Airport City Centre (10 min. walk from Hilton) and v.v. by minibusses available at approx. CZK 100 (USD 3.5 /person/journey) or minivans (check the fare at the Airport).
